MOTION IN LIMINE REGARDING JOHN MASER

NOW COMES Defendant John Kim and files this Motion in Limine asking the court to bar the government from calling John Maser as a witness and in support of same would show the court as follows:

1. The government has indicated that it plans to call John Maser as a witness in this matter.
2. Maser was connected to the martial arts schools in Illinois from 1972 until 1984.
